



You are cordially invited to participate in the 13th annual National Homebuilders Compensation Survey. The participation form (Participation Form.pdf), data collection package (dcf_hb1.pdf), practices forms (Practices.pdf), Module A Forms (Module A Forms.pdf) and the Excel spreadsheet (excel_hb1.xls) are attached. These forms and files are also on our website - www.analyticalfmi.com.

For 2010, we are adding one new position. This makes a new total of 94 jobs being surveyed. The new position is Internet Sales Consultant.

Please take extra time completing the scope measures for 1st and 2nd Level positions and for the Practices Section. We continue to receive sketchy information from many companies and hope you will work with us this year to improve the quality of the data. It is especially important to provide sales and revenue numbers for 1st and 2nd level heads. Complete "scope" data will allow you to use the final report more effectively. The Participation, Practices and Module A forms are also interactive PDF's.

Payment for the survey is \$2,200 if you submit your data electronically or \$2,600 if you submit your data on paper. These amounts reflect a slight increase and represent our first price increase since 2005. Payment is due no later than when you return your data collection package. **You will be invoiced when you confirm your intention to participate by emailing or faxing the enclosed Participation Form to (602) 381-8228.** Please return the form promptly.

If you want to submit your data electronically, you can use the attached Excel spreadsheet or download it from our web site. Instructions for using the spreadsheet are in the instruction tab on the spreadsheet. It is helpful to print the data collection package that has the instructions, organization charts of reporting relationships, job descriptions and other survey forms. We can accept almost any form of electronic submission as long as it has all the requested information. If you want to submit the data using another format, please call so we can verify that it is compatible.

You are also invited to participate in our tenth annual survey of Executive Compensation. The Executive Compensation Survey (Module A) provides information on base compensation, short-term incentive plans, long-term incentive plans, perquisites and executive level benefits for all corporate level positions and 1st and 2nd Level Heads. Sections include cash, performance and stock-based plans. We also provide a breakout of your data from the other participants on the "pie chart" pages of the report and provide a section of proxy data for all publicly traded homebuilders.

If you also intend to participate in the 2010 Executive Compensation Survey, please check the appropriate box on the enclosed Participation Form. Data for Module A may be submitted electronically or on paper. You can enter the compensation data on the Excel spreadsheet and the plan descriptions on the Module A Forms. The data
